

Presidents Corner

The clipping operation went very well, thanks to all our good volunteers. Chris Underhill did a outstanding job in running the clipping in the trailer. When there's a job to do our good volunteers just get it done. I want to thank Wayne Krieger for being a most informative quest speaker at our last general meeting. We sure had enough rain, each time we have a storm we get a lot of sand and dirt in the raceways, the crews just finished cleaning them out again. We will be starting to rebuild the floor under the egg trays. We have a new pan that Wayne Adams made for us, and floor lumber donated by John Wilson. We won't be meeting at the Fair Grounds again as our turn out is too low. Next general will be at the Hatchery. We will start our Hatchery tours again, on Wed, Fri & Sat. Who ever is feeding on those days must call the Indian Creek Store 247-7704 at 9AM, don't forget.

General Meeting

June 10, 2010

<u>**Tom Tostenson,**</u> president, called the meeting to order at 10am. We did not have a very good turnout for the breakfast and we need to meet elsewhere. The minutes of last month's meeting were approved as printed in *The Riffle*. <u>Hassie Taylor</u>, treasurer, reported that we had a gain for the month of \$10,269 and an end of month balance of \$24,522. The figures are deceiving as the money was received for the new oxygen system, but the bill of \$12,563 hasn't been paid yet. We have been breaking even on the monthly meeting raffle, but everyone would still like Katie to continue it.

Presentation by State Representative, Wayne Krieger- Rep. Krieger discussed the content in the OR. Revised Statutes (ORS) that governs some of the operating directives for ODFW. Not all of the intent of the statutes is being adhered to and other parts of the statutes are being politically interpreted. There are conflicts having to do with special interest groups. The state hasn't opened new hatcheries or updated existing hatcheries because of the anti hatchery governing that promotes 'wild' fish management. Rep. Krieger gave some of the figures from a 2003 cormorant management study, which showed a 50% smolt loss due to cormorants. A seal predation study on the Siletz River showed a smolt reduction correlation. Rep. Krieger's closing statement was the statistic showing the hatchery program as a \$40 mil. cost with a \$400 mil. return. CAF appreciated Rep. Krieger taking the time to meet with us.

Fin Clipping- Chris Underhill reported that 85,722 fish were clipped in 40 hours. Not only fantastic, but there were only 10 mortalities (of fish)!

<u>Derby-</u>Mike Kopec reported that the Indian Creek Hatchery Derby will be on Sep. 18th from 7am until 4pm. Cost will be \$35/person including dinner. Mike is working on a logo and derby clothing and will announce more details later.

<u>Tours-</u> Since some of the feeders don't like giving tours, we will reduce the number of days that tours will be offered. Once the days of the week are decided, a notice will be posted. If the feeders on that day don't want to give a tour, they will have to call one of the 4 listed people to come down and give the tour.

<u>Raffle-</u> Kate DeBord definitely has a handle on the raffle. Thanks Kate.

I think that is a job <u>Well Done</u>, on one day they clipped 28,380 fish and good, clean clips. Thank you clippers, crowders, cookers and everyone who helped out, especially my husband who was there crowding, cooking and prepping everyday.

Next, we had Libby Pond, it was the first really sunny day, I think it reached 80 degrees. Dianne McKenzie, your tents were lifesavers, Thank you. We had around 60 kids enter the derby and Bob & Leanne O'Neil registered them all, then tallied all the measurements, you two were <u>AWESOME</u> and they called me, to volunteer! Thank you to the Humbug Shriners, Oregon South Coast Fishermen and our own CAF Moron Patrol Good Ole Boys who hauled, prepped, set up, tore down, cooked and hung out all morning, all you guys were GREAT! Thank you also to ODFW Joey Denbo who along with myself went around to businesses and picked up many items donated for prizes, we have such a giving community, Thank you Gold Beach, Pt. 
