#### CAF General Meeting-July 14, 2016

<u>President</u>- David Sophusson called the meeting to order at 10:06am. The minutes from the June general meeting were approved as printed in the July edition of *The Riffle*.

<u>Treasurer's report-</u> Barbara Huff reported a monthly loss of \$106 for the month of June. There will be expenses in July and August related to the derby and the country music festival.

Hatchery- Gary Underhill asked David to report: the approximately 14,000 fish from raceway #2 were released, since ODFW was not concerned about increasing the Bacterial Kidney Disease (BKD) in the ocean population; someone (to be announced) donated a new BBQ to CAF; after all fish have been released, the #3 liner will be replaced, Knox's will fix their cattle guard and some asphalt work may be done in the front of the raceways.

Music Festival- Mary Tindill has the volunteer work positions filled for the Hospitality area and Becky Sophusson has the volunteer positions filled for the pancake feed as well as the supplies ready to go. An email will be sent with the last minute details and assignments.

Volunteer Coordinator-Chris Underhill will be reducing her involvement after this rearing season and CAF will need to define (if possible!) all the work Chris has been doing for the past 11 years to make sure our tremendously successful hatchery operations continue to function efficiently, thoroughly and with minimum overload on our great team of volunteers. How many people do we need to replace Chris?

<u>The Riffle-</u>Richard McKinney continues to publish our newsletter on time and updated with the latest information. Richard welcomes all suggestions for improvement.

## **Hatchery Happenings**

Hi CAF volunteers this summer is flying by, we released raceway #2 on July 5<sup>th</sup>, now we are down to two raceways with approximately 30,000 fry in each raceway. The fry are eating like pigs; attention daily feeders please DO NOT REMOVE THE BASKETS ON THE VACUUM PUMPS except to clean them. Larry Cody had to repair the pump on raceway #1. Someone vacuumed without the basket in sucking up pine cones and needles into the pump. Please DO NOT REMOVE THE BASKETS WHILE VACUUMING.

Thanks to Richard McKinney and Rod Black, and the Oregon South Coast Fishermen who showed up at the last minute to help John Weber fisheries biologist for the south region of the Oregon Department of Fish & Wildlife providing instruction on the Rogue River history, fish types including, knot tying, casting instruction plus 50 rods and reels were given to the tribal kids at the camp grounds north of Lobster Creek Bridge. The kids had a blast fishing on the Rogue River.


