The meeting was called to order at 7:21pm by CAF President, David Sophusson. After welcoming everyone and thanking them doing a fantastic job of raising the 2016 smolts, David introduced Chris Underhill. Chris expressed her sincere appreciation for everyone's help and cooperation for another successful year of operating and maintaining the Indian Creek Hatchery. David asked CAF Secretary, Glenn Kral, to conduct the election of the 2017 Board of Directors.

<u>Election of Board of Directors-</u> CAF secretary, Glenn Kral, announced that there are 3 vacancies for the 2017 election. Glenn presented the slate of members that agreed to serve on the 2017 Board:

CAF General Meeting

Feb. 9, 2017

Glenn Kral-In the absence of the president and vice-president, the CAF secretary called the meeting to order at 10:01am. The minutes from the December general meeting were approved as printed in the Dec. edition of *The Riffle*. Glenn introduced and welcomed 2 of the 3 new board members- Linda Tarwater and Joe Janowicz – and thanked them for volunteering to serve on the board. The other new board member is Aaron Duncan. Glenn reported that the board of directors has approved the following officers for 2017:

President- David Sophusson Vice-President- Gary Underhill Treasurer- Barbara Huff Secretary- Glenn Kral

Treasurer-Barbara Huff reported Jan. income of \$136.01 and expenses of \$1,035.55. The proposed 2017 budget was prepared by Becky Sophusson and is being reviewed by the board. Approximate annual operating costs for the hatchery are \$22,000. Yearly donations approved by the board were: \$200 to the Sea Lion Patrol, \$300 to Oregon Stewardship and \$100 to 4-H.

<u>The Riffle-</u>Hassie Taylor, former editor, is preparing the Feb. edition for mailing at the beginning of March. With the departure of Richard McKinney, Hassie graciously offered to produce *The Riffle* on a quarterly basis. Becky

Sophusson may be willing to help produce issues of *The Riffle*. The board would like to have someone produce a monthly edition. Linda Tarwater volunteered to put together an email list and send reminders about the monthly general meetings.

ODFW-At last week's board meeting, John Weber discussed the timeline for renewing the Propagation Plan (PP) for the hatchery by PP October 1. The governs all how/when/where/how details many from collecting broodstock through fish release. Copies of the 78 page document have been emailed to all board members for review/update. Steve Mazur explained the details of the ODFW grant request to the R&E board to improve Arizona Beach Pond fishing conditions. The request addresses vegetation, sediment removal and depth. The board approved \$1,000 in matching funds for the project, as did the South Coast Fishermen group.

<u>Scholarships-</u> Applications are due from the 3 high schools by the end of March.

2017 Salmon Derby-Mary Duncan is in charge of the derby and is working with Jim Carey from The Rogue Outdoor Store. Mary was concerned about the entrants for the post Labor Day timeframe and the board agreed to Mary's suggestion to approach Jim Carey about moving the derby to Thur.-Fri.-Sat. in mid- August. There was a discussion about more members helping Mary with prizes, publicity and award categories.

Dorothy and Eldridge Combs Memorial Fund-Glenn will talk to the LRWC about the return of unused funds for Arizona Beach signage.
