Last year we were approached by Gold Beach High School staff who requested us to help them set up a fish raising-program to raise Chinook Salmon from egg to fry. CAF will be providing some equipment and approximately 100 eggs to get this project off the ground.

Last December we held our annual election of officers at our appreciation dinner party. Glen Kubli, the new owner of Honey Bear by the Sea, hosted us for the night. Glen and his staff went way over the top with the layout and festive decorations. We all had a great time and the food was awesome. Everything went so well that we already reserved them for next year.

Things at the hatchery are going very well and everything seems to be on track and running smoothly.

There are some new developments on the horizon. Several upgrades are underway at Arizona Pond with the future possibility of more varied use of the pond with potential family and special needs access for fishing and recreation. Steve Mazer and John Weber (ODFW) are working with Mary Duncan in obtaining funding for additional enhancement of Arizona Pond.

I am looking forward to working with all of you doing what we do best, raising salmon.

CAF General Meeting

November 9, 2017

<u>Call to Order</u>-President, David Sophusson, called the meeting to order at 10:09 am. The minutes from the September-November meetings were approved as published in the Sept.-Nov. #114 edition of *The Riffle*.

<u>Treasurer-</u>Barbara Huff reported a monthly profit of \$485.28.

2017 Pizza Fundraiser – CAF made a profit of \$2,252.64 at our annual pizza fundraiser on November 1st with over 160 presale tickets sold. Many thanks to Fred. N. and Joe J. We also sold 8 hatchery caps and collected \$175.00 in donations.

Hatchery-John Weber announced the hatchery spawning schedule beginning Wednesday, November 15th and continuing each Tuesday thereafter until spawning is complete. He anticipates as many as 45 fish to be spawned. Spawning will begin at 9:00 am. We currently have 120-140 fish in the holding tank.

Gary Underhill reported: Arizona Pond has been cleaned up and is now free of weeds. A permanent structure at the pond was discussed. Gary mentioned that the new bathroom at the hatchery is set to be leveled and plumbed. The incubation room is being cleaned; the installation on liner #3 is on hold. Dave B. is attempting to make it a "rat free" zone, as well as repairing the deck outside the hatchery. Gary is setting up the hydrogen peroxide schedule.

<u>Visitor Center –</u> A trifold display of the spawning process is set up at the Gold Beach Visitor Center during the spawning season. The purpose of the display is to educate the public and invite their attendance at our spawning events.


