

# **CAF General Meeting**

**September 13, 2018** 

Vice-President - Gary Underhill called the meeting to order at 10am. The minutes of the August meeting were approved as published in The Riffle.

<u>Treasurer</u> - Barbara Huff reported a monthly gain \$6,042.97, thanks to Mary Duncan and helpers with the Salmon Derby. The yearly loss to date is \$1,330.

Hatchery - Gary Underhill reported: the brood tank is ready; screens are off the emergency pumps; work parties for the ladder, 12" waterline repair, moving the flush gate and repairing the drain on raceway #1.

2018 Salmon Derby -Mary Duncan has awarded the last of the prizes and all the derby items are stored at the port. There are some outstanding expenses.

**Grant Request** - Dave Barnes submitted the request for new egg stacks and was contacted by the R&E board to see if the used stacks in Florence would work. Dave said the stacks in Florence were not acceptable and he will participate by phone with the R&E Board's meeting. ODFW can get new stacks at a fair

price and will work with us to coordinate replacements.

<u>Pizza Fundraiser</u> - Mary Duncan offered to coordinate the fundraiser with Sunset Family Pizza and arrange the printing of tickets and fliers. There are volunteers ready to bake goodies to sell for additional profit. Thanks, Mary.

<u>Cedar Creek Hatch Boxes</u> - John Wilson will allow the hatch boxes again this season. Several CAF volunteers will make sure the program continues. ODFW would like to involve students in the project.

Gold Beach High School - Jack Sheehan will check on the status of the salmon rearing project. Most of the fish were to be released, but some will be retained for a salt water rearing phase.

<u>December Meeting</u> - The board needs to discuss the date and location for the annual dinner/election meeting.

## **CAF General Meeting**

October 11, 2018

<u>Secretary</u> - Glenn Kral called the meeting to order at 10:05am. The minutes from the September meeting will be published in the next newsletter.

<u>Treasurer</u> - Barbara Huff reported a net income of \$932.23 for September but a net loss of \$397.77 for the year. Insurance in the amount of \$780 was the biggest expense.

**Hatchery** - Gary Underhill reported at last week's board meeting: the fish ladder boards have been replaced; the 12"pipe seal has been replaced; there are 5 fish in the brood tank; the alarm system is activated; the hydrogen peroxide treatment will begin; the drain on raceway #1 has shifted; #2 channels are good.

**2018 Salmon Derby** - Mary Duncan reported that all expenses are in and all the awards have been delivered. The net income through the end of Sept. was \$6,679.32. There are a couple of improvements needed for next year.

The Riffle - Mary is handling the next issue and is waiting for input about the Dec. meeting. The issue will be mailed with enough time to reach members 30 days in advance of the Dec. meeting. Barb will talk to the Post Office about having a prepaid credit account to facilitate mailings. Hassie will handle the Dec. issue and will need all input by Nov. 19th to assure it's mailed before the annual meeting.

<u>Pizza Fundraiser</u> - Mary has organized the event for Nov. 7<sup>th</sup>; 5-7pm. Tickets will be available soon. There will be desserts and raffle items. Mary needs help with ticket sales, advertising and bringing service supplies from the hatchery.

<u>December meeting</u> - Hassie will check with Honey Bear about the Dec. 8<sup>th</sup> date and report to the board about menu choices and prices.

Gold Beach High School Project - all except 10 fish were released. The remaining 10 will be used in a salt water rearing project. Mary will publish the Facebook page the students are using for updates.

<u>Cedar Valley Hatch Boxes</u> - John Wilson will be asked for approval to bring students to the site. Transportation may be available to bring high school or 4-H students to help. CAF volunteers will oversee the project this year with or without student involvement.

**Resource Day** - The event is for Curry County 5<sup>th</sup> graders in early May.

<u>Scholarships</u> - Jack Sheehan will have applications to the schools by year end.

**Spawning** - John Weber will be coordinating the schedule with Hassie and Gary. The meeting was adjourned at 11:20 a.m.

#### **Gold Beach High School Project**

Kit Keusink, a junior at Gold Beach High School, and staff members at the school have been conducting an experiment using Chinook Salmon eggs supplied by Indian Creek Fish Hatchery. The eggs were housed in a fish tank at the high school and the fry grew to a healthy size. Most have been released into Indian Creek; however, ten of the fish are still under observation in the fish tank as they gradually become acclimated to sea water over time.
