President's Corner

Some of you may be wondering (now that June has come and gone), why there has been no mention of fin clipping our fish to identify our hatchery salmon from wild salmon. Normally we would have clipped the adipose fin off all the fish by mid-June. But the clipping trailer that ODFW supplies us with each year was needed by others with a higher priority. So, we will be clipping almost a month late this year starting on July 10th and will probably take at least four days to complete. Now that I think about it, that might not be such a bad thing as the fish will be bigger. So those of us with, let's say, ageing eyes will have a better chance of seeing that dang tiny little fin to clip. Also, like last year, we will again be marking the first 25000 - 28000 with a coded wire tag that will identify them to our hatchery and the year they were released. It should be interesting in a few years to see the results.

CAF General Meeting June 14, 2018

President-David Sophusson called the meeting to order at 10:10am. The minutes from May will be in the next newsletter.

Treasurer-Barbara Huff reported a loss for May of \$1,099.92 and a year-to-date loss of \$8,912.11. The income is normally low in the first half of the year and we have the increased expense of the very impressive office area remodel.

Hatchery-Gary Underhill reported: the oxygen system is on and the DO readings are good; the fish are feeding well; volunteers need make sure the strainer baskets are in the vacuums; there will be a garbage clean-up tomorrow; there are 3 orphaned baby skunks hanging around; the screens on the REDD units need to be cleaned on a daily basis.

2018 Salmon Derby-Mary Duncan received approval from the board to spend \$360 on 66 multi-state radio stations advertising for the week before the derby. Sunset Family Pizza will be the location for the awards dinner.

ODFW-John Weber thanked everyone who helped with the 60 students that participated in the June 8th Reel Fishing Day.

<u>College Scholarships-</u>Jack Sheehan presented a \$500 scholarship to Nathan Malamud of Pacific High School




Doctor
