

## **CAF** General Meeting

November 14, 2019

Besides raising and then putting 80,000 to 100,000 young salmon in the Rogue River every year, we show the residents and visitors in Curry County how we do this and who makes it happen.

To get this message out, we have a meeting on the second Thursday of every month except in December and January. This takes place in the meeting room at Jots Resort. It is open to all. The meeting typically starts at 10:00 a.m. and lasts about 1-1/2 hours. After the members and guests hear about what is happening at the Indian Creek Hatchery, we have a raffle and the lucky ticket holder(s) receive a gift certificate worth up to \$50.
