



## STAC: What is it, and why care?

The Salmon and Trout Advisory Committee (STAC) was established with STEP in 1981 to serve as an advisory committee to the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) and the Fish and Wildlife Commission. STAC duties outlined in statute include:

- The review of ODFW policies concerning the implementation of STEP
- To make recommendations to the Department and the Commission
- Be the voice of the STEP programs in their area.

In addition, STAC will help administer the STAC mini-grant program which provides monetary support for qualifying projects. There are 9 regional committee representatives.

OK, that is a bunch of words. What does it mean to you as a STEP member/volunteer? Simply stated, as the Southern Coast STAC representative, I am your voice to the ODFW

Commission and the ODFW staff. It is my responsibility to keep you informed of policies and initiatives that will affect you and the fish you support here in the Southern Oregon Coast Region. In turn, I keep the committee informed regarding your concerns and comments as well as projects that you are engaged with.

Recently we were fortunate enough to have STAC as well as ODFW staff here on the Southern Oregon Coast. This was one of 3 meetings held annually around the state. The engagement from both Oregon South Coast Fishermen (OSCF) and Curry Anadromous Fishermen (CAF) was noted and very much appreciated by STAC.

The main topic of this meeting was the updating of the Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) with respect to STEP/STAC. These rules had not been updated since 1986 (Yes, it was time!) and have been undergoing extensive review by ODFW staff, ODFW STEP biologist, STAC members and STEP clubs, as well as many concerned citizens for over a year now. This effort has been challenging to say the least, but with the help of all we are getting close to finalizing the rules.

While there have been countless people that have been involved, I want to personally thank several people that attended the STAC meeting here in Gold Beach. OSCF was represented by Dave Kuehn, Leonard Krug, and Rich Heap. and CAF was represented by Mary Duncan, Bruce Blanthorn, and Joe Janowitz.

# Ways to help the Hatchery through donations

As many of you are aware, we have been getting donations from the collection of McKay's receipts as well as by linking your Ray's rewards cards to the hatchery account. The board thanks everyone for their help with these rewards programs. As a reminder:

#### McKay's

McKay's will rebate back to the hatchery 1% of eligible purchased items. Receipts must be dated within the last 12 months and all McKay's receipts, not just Gold Beach, are eligible. There are collection containers at the following locations: Oceanside RV Park, Turtle Cove RV Park, Indian Creek RV park, the Crow's Nest restaurant, Rogue Outdoor Store, and at the hatchery itself, or they may be turned in at any monthly meeting.

#### Ray's

With your Ray's rewards card, talk to a manager and have them go into their computer and link your card to Curry Anadromous Fishermen, account number 50642. Then, each time you make a purchase at Ray's, give them your rewards card number or phone number. A donation will be sent to us each quarter.

#### Fred Meyer


Link your Rewards Card to the hatchery at fredmeyer.com. Enrolling is an easy process that's clearly outlined on the site. Customers can begin earning donations for our nonprofit when they shop at Fred Meyer using a linked Rewards Card. This is an ongoing program and customers may enroll at any time. First log into your account and next select Community Rewards; it is on the left side. Type Curry Anadromous Fishermen in the search bar. Once our organization comes up hit enroll. This will not affect your existing Fred Meyer's rewards or gas rewards program; you will just be providing a donation to the hatchery with eligible purchases.

#### **Amazon Smile**

On your first visit to AmazonSmile, <a href="mailto:smile.amazon.com">smile.amazon.com</a>, you need to select a charitable organization to receive the donations from eligible purchases before you begin shopping. Amazon will remember your selection, and then every eligible purchase you make at <a href="mailto:smile.amazon.com">smile.amazon.com</a> will result in a donation. This cannot, at this time, be accessed from the Amazon App for iOS or Android, so you will need to access through a web browser. If you have an existing Amazon

account this will not affect it, you will just be providing a donation to the hatchery with eligible purchases. This program is a great way for friends and family from out of town to help support our hatchery.




#### **SCHOLARSHIPS FOR 2022**


