

During the last ten years in Shaver Lake, Warren managed a hardware store and worked in a sign shop. The previous 30 years were spent working construction doing drywall.

Raising Huskie-wolf dogs over a period of ten years became a hobby, and after meeting a woman who had been raising wolves. Warren and Linda experimented with cross-breeding. As they were searching for a new home, they were drawn to the Oregon coast and fell in love with what they saw. In 2022 they were heading for greener pastures, namely, Gold Beach, where, according to Warren, the weather is "almost perfect" and the people are so friendly. Here they are enjoying their quiet lifestyle, mixing in a little exploration of Oregon in their RV camper and working on upgrading their home.


