

January 13, 2011

<u>David Sophusson</u>, president, called the meeting to order at 10:05am. The minutes of last month's meeting were approved as printed in *The Riffle*. The officers for 2011 are: David Sophusson, president; Gary Underhill, vice president; Hassie Taylor, treasurer; Glenn Kral, secretary.

<u>Treasurer's report-</u> Hassie Taylor reported a Dec. loss of \$979.82 and a year end bank balance of \$19,104.28. Becky Sophusson will handle the bookkeeping duties and is working with Hassie to present a balanced budget at the next board meeting. Hassie emphasized that everyone needs to be recruiting new members and helping find new sponsors and retain present sponsors.

Fundraisers- We will have 3 major fundraisers (fireworks, derby, pizza) and the BBQ/Open House. Everyone should be thinking of a new fundraiser that might be more of an annual event that we build into something profitable/reliable.

Hatchery- Vice president, Gary Underhill, reported that the counting is almost over and we will have an adequate supply of very viable eggs. By the end of the month we will have a fish food delivery and we will need to prepare raceway 1. Tom Tostenson brought up some concerns for next year's spawning schedule. The group discussed some issues about the new fish pump that ODFW is pursuing through a grant.

<u>The Riffle-</u> Editor, John Lento, needs a trainee to take over in the near future (anytime soon!). The time commitment is minimal and the format is very user friendly. John will publish a prominent request in the next issue.

<u>Kate DeBord-</u> Kate was very relaxed after the holiday break and raffled off some great prizes. She'd like to see a lot more attendees at the meetings.

From Glenn Kral






