General Meeting

March 10, 2011

Gary Underhill, vice president, called the meeting to order at 10:00am. The minutes of last month's meeting were approved as printed in *The Riffle*.

Treasurer's report- Hassie Taylor's preliminary report shows a February gain of \$411 and a month end bank balance of \$18,682. She sent out 32 letters to members in arrears for dues as of 2009 or earlier and 14 have paid. The members discussed the requirements for our non-profit mailing and John Lento, *The Riffle* editor, stated that we need at least 200 mailings per month. We currently mail 235 copies.

Hatchery- Vice president, Gary Underhill, reported that all the fish are in the raceways and volunteers will be doing hand feeding for a few weeks before he installs the mechanical feeders. Bo Gemeinhardt donated a new D.O. meter (THANKS BO), which will only be used by those that have been trained in its use. Now that all 3 raceways are filled, the automatic D.O. system will be activated.

Volunteer Coordinator- As always, we need more volunteer feeders. There will be a children's Reel Fishing Day at Arizona Beach in April and the annual Free Children's Fishing Day at Libby Pond in June. CAF will sponsor an open house at the hatchery on July 4th. Philip Dickson led a discussion about recognition of volunteer hours with an achievement pin.

Miscellaneous- The new trash pump has been purchased. The R&E board approved the grant for the new fish pump and it will be ordered when we receive the check. Mike Kopec gave the details for the STEP BBQ at Rockaway Beach. Hassie Taylor is working with John Lento as a backup editor for *The Riffle*.

Kate DeBord- Thanks to Mike Kopec, Katie had finally some descent raffle items.

Hatchery Happenings

It's been a very wet March as we all know, but the fish don't seem to mind. All three raceways are eating great and we just started using the automatic feeders. Weber, Curtis, and I weighed the fish March 17th and Rwy #1 with 28,656 fry was at 384 per pound, Rwy #2 with 27,159 was 404 per lb., and Rwy #3 with 27,184 was 564 per lb. The babies look great and now it's time for the cleaning of the raceways to start. Daily feeders, please brush down all screens in all raceways, then vacuum and scrub the walls of your assigned raceway. The monthly schedule also has the vacuum schedule on it. If it is bad weather or you are unable to vacuum, please note it in the notebook. Feed will be pre-measured and located on the shelf in the closet; remember to check the feed door one last time before you leave. We can't risk a mouse or rat getting into the feed room. PLEASE REMEMBER TO CALL ME OR FETZER WHEN DONE so we know the job has been completed. If you ever have a question or need a refresher, give me a call.

We have the Arizona Beach Reel Days coming up April 20, 21, 27 & 28th. That's where ODFW, CAF, and OSCF join forces to teach 3rd graders from Gold Beach, Brookings, and Pt. Orford how to fish at Arizona Beach State Park. We could really use some more volunteers. We start at 8 AM and are usually done by 2 PM with lunch included. It's great to help a child catch their first fish; the smiles are priceless. Be brave! We have a great record of no person or child getting hooked, except on fishing, and you'll also enjoy a good lunch.

I'd also like to give everyone a heads-up on upcoming events. The fish-clipping trailer will be coming to the hatchery the last week of May. We have the Libby Pond Free Fishing Derby on Sat. June 11th and CAF will be running the 4th of July Fireworks Booth at Rogue Outdoor Store. An Open House is also planned for the 4th of July at the hatchery from 10 AM to 2 PM, so if you have any family coming in for the 4th, plan on hitting the hatchery to feed the fish and get a hot dog.


