

General Meeting

October 14, 2010

Tom Tostenson, president, called the meeting to order at 10:10am. The minutes of last month's meeting were approved as printed in *The Riffle*.

Bo Gemeinhardt reported that we have 23 wild fish in the holding tank and they are all in great condition. Once we get some rain, our Indian Creek fish should be able to get to the hatchery. ODFW needs volunteer help at Huntley Park on M,W,F. Bo and Gary are getting the hatchery ready for spawning and expect to have our first spawning on Nov. 15. We will spawn 45 pairs this year. There was a discussion about having an open house on à Saturday during spawning to give the public a good idea of all the work we do at that stage of the rearing cycle.

<u>Treasurer's report-</u> Tom reported we had a gain for the month of \$3,671 and an end of month balance of \$19,955. The major income item for the month came from the derby.

Mike Kopec reported that the derby netted \$4,700 and we have prize money left over for next year's derby. Mike did a super job putting on his first derby. Tom will get a price on laminating the leftover posters so they could be sold as placemats.

<u>Pizza Fundraiser-</u> We had a decent turnout of 120 people and made a little over \$700. I did not follow through on getting an article in the newspaper nor did I contact the visitor center or the chamber. We will be better prepared next time. Everyone did a great job making sure that service went smoothly.

Board Nominations- A list of potential board candidates will be printed in the newsletter. Most candidates are present board members, but we hope different members will volunteer to serve and relieve some of us who have been on the board a long time. It would be nice to have different perspectives and fresh ideas.

<u>Fireworks-</u> We have received the paperwork for next year. The members present voted to sell fireworks again. Becky and David Sophusson would consider being in charge. Based on last year's results and experience, we could do better next year.

<u>Kate DeBord</u> ran a smooth-as-silk raffle and was very relaxed. She will do a clothing inventory so we know what we need to order for next year.


