CAF General Meeting

Nov. 13, 2014

<u>President-</u> David Sophusson called the meeting to order at 10:00am. David expressed our CAF appreciation to Jot's Resort for accommodating our monthly meeting in their exercise room due to furniture stored in their meeting rooms during their extensive renovation. David and Becky are glad to be home.

<u>Minutes-</u> The minutes for the October meeting were approved as printed in *The Riffle*.

Treasurer's reportBarbara Jorge reported that the financial data is current now that Becky Sophusson is back and has updated the bookkeeping. The accounting for the BiMart Country Music Festival is complete, but there are still a few items coming in for the derby. There was a gain of \$2,264 for the month of October. The mistake on the IRS reporting has been corrected with no consequence. Hassie Taylor will coordinate with Ray Barmore on the listing of paid sponsors that should be listed in The Riffle and on the website.

Hatchery- Gary Underhill reported that yesterday was the first spawning and 10 pairs were spawned. ODFW has set our goal at 40 pairs and doesn't anticipate a problem with our mixture of hatchery and wild fish. The next spawning will be on the 18th. Gary will coordinate the retrieval of more spawners from Indian Creek. The filtration system is operating to regulate the water for the egg trays.

2015 BiMart Country Music Festivalboard of directors appointed Becky Sophusson
to be the chairwoman for the pancake breakfast
and VIP hospitality. Becky will coordinate with
the board on planning, budget, equipment and
volunteers. Becky and Dave hosted a dinner for
this year's festival volunteers and Becky
summarized many of the details that need to be
addressed next year. The festival organizers
were very impressed with CAF's organization
this year and appreciated all our volunteers.

December Election/General meeting DinnerAn open discussion was held about the choices for the upcoming meeting. At last week's board meeting the directors decided to not pay for the Dec. meeting, but CAF will fund a volunteer appreciation function next summer. There were eight board members present, so Jim Freedman suggested a vote from the audience of their

preferences on the dinner. David then called for a motion to the board.

MOTION- by Jack Sheehan, second by John Epps, that the meeting be held at Honey Bear Campground on Dec. 5th for a cost of \$12/meal and attendees pay for their meal. The motion was approved unanimously by the 8 board members.

Gary Underhill will make sure that the volunteer coordinator knows about the board's decision *The Riffle* – Editor, Hassie Taylor, requested that inputs be submitted by Nov. 17th and she will be able to have the newsletter mailed by Dec. 1st. Hassie needs member inputs to meet the requirement for 75% non-advertising content.

Merry Christmas Everyone!

Boy this year has flown by, and once again we have eggs in the incubator room, and the fun begins! We had our first spawning on Nov. 12th and with many volunteers help, we pulled eggs and milt from our first group of Chinook Salmon. This means we have Stack #1 up and running with 10 trays so far, and the daily feeder calendar starts up again. If there is anyone who is unable to continue with their scheduled day, please call me 541 247-0396.

Daily feeders need to stop by the hatchery, check water flow into stacks in use, check temperature in top tray of Stack #1, enter temp. in book, then subtract 32 from temp. for the Thermal Units or TU's and enter that in book, and "wah-la" you're done! Anyone who needs a refresher on what we do, please call, Gary's at the hatchery almost every day.

I'd like to thank Jack Sheehan for talking to the Gold Beach High School Science classes and getting high school kids to help out with spawning and pathology. The kids did a great job and helped out a lot on our first day of spawning, we look forward to their help for the rest of spawning.



Tomorrow, Nov. 18th is our next spawning date and we have Mrs. Hoffman's 3rd grade class coming to visit the hatchery and watch the volunteers spawn, then, hopefully we'll get to go up the creek and find salmon spawning naturally. Thank you Pat Eakles; he loves making these awesome chocolate chip cookies for the kids.

You know I'd like to throw in a big Thank You to Gary, Larry, Art, Charlie, Bo, Dean, Pat, Scott, Marcia, Aaron, Dave, Gary H, Don, Mary, and a few names I've probably missed for helping collect broodstock throughout Oct. & Nov. and doing the Peroxide Treatments. We have a great group of volunteers that hop too at a phone call! Thank you to the ladies: Dru, Barb, Louise, BJ, Kathy and myself for the desserts, salads and soups we feed the volunteers. I must admit, the gang is spoiled by good cooking! Lastly, we are having the CAF Christmas Party/Election this year on Friday, Dec. 5th at Honey Bear Campgrounds. 


